ACARA School ID		Unique ID allocated to a given school by ACARA.
Calendar Year		The year to which the data relates.
School Name	Displayed in the title with Suburb and State	The official name of the school.
Suburb	Displayed in the title with School Name and State	The suburb in which the school is located.
State	Displayed in the title with School Name and Suburb	The state in which the school is located.
Postcode		The postcode of the school's location.
School Sector		The sector that the school belongs to (G=Government, C=Catholic, I=Independent).
School Type	School facts - School type	The type of school (Primary, Secondary, Combined or Special).
ACARA Head Campus ID		ACARA Head Campus ID is allocated by ACARA to the head campus of a multi-campus school, if applicable. An ID will not be allocated where the school does not have any associated campuses. If it has a value and the value is the same as the ACARA School ID then the school is the main or head campus. If the value is different from the ACARA School ID then the school is an associated campus or subcampus.
Rolled Reporting Description		This field refers to the way in which a school's data is reported on My School: Individual Reporting - for a multi-campus school, data will be reported against each campus individually. All single entity schools will be Individual Reporting. Rolled Reporting - for a multi-campus school, data will be reported against the head campus only.
Domain	NAPLAN - Student gain	One of the five domains or learning areas tested in NAPLAN: Reading, Persuasive Writing, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation, and Numeracy
Calendar Year Range	NAPLAN - Student gain	The calendar year range to which the data relates.
Student Grade Level		The school year level being tested: year 3, year 5, year 7 or year 9.
Student Grade Level Range	NAPLAN - Student gain	The school year level range to which the data relates.
School Mean NAPLAN Score	NAPLAN - Student gain	The mean NAPLAN scale score for matched students at the selected school, for the selected domain and student grade level. Matched students are those students who sat two consecutive NAPLAN tests at the same school and have results at two year levels. This value will be suppressed on <i>My School</i> if there are fewer than five matched students.
School Mean Lower Margin	NAPLAN - Student gain	The lower bound confidence interval of the matched student mean NAPLAN scale score based on a margin of error at 90% level of confidence. This value will be suppressed on <i>My School</i> if there are fewer than five matched students.
School Mean Upper Margin	NAPLAN - Student gain	The upper bound confidence interval of the matched student mean NAPLAN scale score based on a margin of error at 90% level of confidence. This value will be suppressed on <i>My School</i> if there are fewer than five matched students.
School Median NAPLAN Score	NAPLAN - Student gain	The median NAPLAN scale score for matched students at the selected school, for the selected domain and student grade level. Matched students are those students who sat two consecutive NAPLAN tests at the same school and have results at two year levels. This value will be suppressed on <i>My School</i> if there are fewer than five matched students.
School Median Lower Margin	NAPLAN - Student gain	The lower bound confidence interval of the matched student median NAPLAN scale score based on a margin of error at 90% level of confidence. This value will be suppressed on <i>My School</i> if there are fewer than five matched students.
School Median Upper Margin	NAPLAN - Student gain	The upper bound confidence interval of the matched student median NAPLAN scale score based on a margin of error at 90% level of confidence. This value will be suppressed on <i>My School</i> if there are fewer than five matched students.
Matched Student Percentage	NAPLAN - Student gain	The number of matched students divided by the number of students who were assessed in the NAPLAN test in the current year, for the selected domain and student grade level, expressed as a percentage.
